- Baltimore County Councilman Julian Jones had a scheduled Town Hall Meeting on September 16 at the Randallstown Library. Were you there?
- Baltimore County is improving nearby streets
 with curbs and gutters, such as Rolling Road
 along with sidewalks from Windsor Mill to
 Orchard Avenue. Maybe some of the streets in

- The Owings Mills Boulevard extension to Liberty Road is nearing completion.
